

## In 2016, the savings on the purchase of medicines under Federal Law # 44 amounted to more than 10%, with a 7% increase in purchases.

In 2016, the amount of completed tenders for the purchase of medicines under Federal Law # 44-FZ1 reached 304.74 billion rubles, which is 7% higher than a year before, with the savings of approximately 13% compared to the originally announced amount of tenders. The number of purchases increased by 8% and amounted to approximately 282 thousand unique order numbers, while the number of recipients decreased by 3% compared to 2015 (Figure 1). The Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation is the largest buyer of tenders for procurement under Federal Law # 44. In 2016, it commissioned medicinal products worth 52.42 billion rubles, which is 4% less than in the previous year. In 2016, there were approximately 4% of savings compared to the initially announced tender amount, versus 1% in 2015.

In 2016, the largest share of purchases under Federal Law # 44 in monetary terms belongs to the Central Federal District with a share of almost 40%. It is followed by the Volga, North-Western and Siberian federal districts with the shares of about 15%, 11% and 11% respectively (Figure 2).

Distribution of the purchases under Federal Law # 44 by federal districts, in monetary terms (rubles, %), 2016.



In 2016, electronic auctions accounted for the largest share of the purchases under Federal Law # 44, classified by the method of finding the supplier (more than 95% in monetary terms). About 2.5% of tenders are for purchase from a single supplier; a little less than 1% can be attributed to requests for quotations.
